20TH ANNUAL WASATCH POWDER KEG SKI RACES.

Brighton \cdot March $19 \cdot 8$ am - 1pm Solitude \cdot March $20 \cdot 8$ -10 am. The Wasatch PowderKeg is one of the premier ski mountaineering (Skimo) races in the US. This year it will be the Youth National Championships as well as a USA Skimo Cup series race, bringing over 200 racers to the canyon. Brighton Resort will host the Individual race on Saturday, with a start and finish at the Milly Lodge. Athletes will be climbing over 5000 vertical feet up and down the Brighton perimeter. Solitude Resort will host an exciting, and spectator friendly, sprint course Sunday morning near Last Chance Mining Camp Lodge.

The sport of ski mountaineering "skimo" has gained increasing popularity in North America over the past few years. It's a very popular sport in Europe where most of the world cup races take place. Skimo will make its debut into

the 2026 winter Olympics in Italy, and some of our racers will be vying for Olympic team positions in the next few years.

Come watch some of the top athletes race up and down the mountains in astonishing speed! Amongst these athletes will be the local Silverfork Skimo athletes. Over 50 youth will be racing this weekend. We invite everyone to come check out this exciting event!
