### **UPD-Cheryl Lenzer**

We had 428 total calls come in for the canyon. 344 of those were generated in the Town of Brighton. We had an assault, a disorderly, camping in a watershed, quite a few traffic accidents, a number of thefts (mostly snowboards and skis from Brighton) and we had a Search and Rescue among our calls for service.

We issued 179 Parking Notices for the month of February. We are getting a lot of positive feedback from the public as we are out issuing notices. Thank you to all who have supported our efforts it means a great deal to us as we usually deal with a lot of upset people over parking. We would appreciate if the resorts would let us in on any events happening that might bring in extra numbers of people. That way we can try and arrange for extra officers a to work enforcement. I worked this past Saturday and the combination of the blue bird day, weekend day, and event at Brighton there were so many parking issues not all of them could be addressed.

**UDOT Update on I-80 and I-215 Construction.** Molly Betebenner presented an overview of the road construction project near the mouth of the canyon. It is due to be finished this year. **Town of Brighton Update.** Jenna reported that the CWC's Big Cottonwood Mobility Action Plan survey will be out for public comment in the coming weeks. The Short-Term Rental Committee will meet later this month. Carolyn reported on a Bill at the Legislature that eliminated the UPD. This will be a challenge for Brighton and the Metros. Efforts are already underway to come up with alternatives.
