You will see a total of 182 calls came in for BCC last month. That is an increase of about 40 calls from last year. The majority of the calls are for public assists that don't generally generate a formal written report. We also had two domestics, a few watersheds involving camping and animals, five traffic accidents, a few suspicious circumstance calls, a burg alarm, a few thefts, and a Search and Rescue. I think we have had a nice break last month from the busy winter. There were several citations for traffic violations written in the lower half of the canyon and 12 parking notices written in the Town of Brighton.

We had two big races in the canyon in the past month. They both ran smoothly for UPD. Hopefully, it was not a major inconvenience for you all.

On June 24, there is the Taylor Hagen Vision Rally motorcycle ride heading up BCC. I don't know how many motorcycles are going to be in the ride but wanted to let you all know that it is going thru the town and over Guardsman towards Park City.

There will be two motors scheduled to come to participate in the 4th of July Parade. I will be there on a mountain bike and hopefully will have a few other officers there participating.

BUSINESS

• **CWC Update** - Comments were submitted from two members of BCC Canyon. The discussion is over tolling. Most agreed on more public transportation. BCCA has concentrated on the "Three T's." BCCA would like to focus on finding transit for the canyon.

- Town of Brighton News- People have been signing up for Chipper Days. Please encourage people to sign up soon. You can find the sign-up for Chipper days on the town of Brighton web page. Please clean up your neighborhood. Jane informed us we could get landfill passes if you take a load in; it is free. Look for election news on the town website.
